Guide dogs work for blind people. Guide dogs walk safely with their owners.

One blind woman says, "I can go out and enjoy many things with my dog. He is my partner and a member of my family. He makes my life happy."

Hearing dogs work for people with hearing problems. When hearing dogs hear an important sound like a phone ringing, they can tell their owners.

Service dogs help people in wheelchairs. Service dogs walk with their owners and open doors for them. If their owners drop something, they can pick it up and give it to the owners.

These assistance dogs are trained well. When they are working, they don't bark at people, or eat food.

You mustn't touch assistance dogs when they are working. You also shouldn't give them food during work. Assistance dogs are like a part of the body for handicapped people. So please understand about assistance dogs and be nice to them.
